# SSRC CODE OF CONDUCT

## Purpose

To ensure that all players, members, spectators, officials and volunteers have a very clear understanding of the behaviour that is expected from everyone and to make it clearly understood that breaches of these codes will result in disciplinary action.

## Coaches are required to:

- Never ridicule or yell at players for errors or poor performance
- Always consider the wellbeing and safety of participants before performance and results
- Encourage participants to value their performance and not their results
- Encourage and guide participants to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour both on and off the court
- Ensure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of participants
- Hold appropriate and valid qualifications before commencing coaching
- To act as role models at all times
- Never smoke or drink alcohol whilst in an official capacity

## Players are required to:

- Play by the rules and respect the umpires' decisions
- Co-operate with their coach/es

## Everyone at SSRC is required to:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or ethnicity
- Support, encourage and involve all players, regardless of their talent level
- Maintain respectful and appropriate relationships with all participants
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play)
- Always respect officials' decisions and support them to carry out their roles
- Display consistently high standards of good sporting behaviour and appearance
- Follow all guidelines laid down by the national governing body and SSRC
- Never condone rule violations, unfair or unduly play rough play or the use of prohibited substances
- Never use offensive language or behaviour
- Adhere to club policies including smoke-free areas and liquor license requirements
- Never behave in a manner that would damage the reputation of the club either on or off the court
- Always welcome opposition players, spectators, officials, etc. to the club
- Adhere to and support SSRC policies
- Be trustworthy
